Principal's Board Report, 30 May

The Principal position for Morley Primary School still has not been decided and the recruitment process is under way and we shall know the outcome by the end of this term.

Activities that have happened since our last Board Meeting include:

- Morley PS is hosting three ATP final year teaching students this term, an EdAssistant Cert IV student and we
 have secured a Master of Social Work field placement student who will commence in Week 8 for 13 weeks.
- Our school chaplain, Mrs Shelby O'Reilly has left ahead of anticipated time and we shall have a replacement chaplain commencing Friday June 1 for the remainder of term on Fridays only. A recruitment process is under way for a new chaplain to work 2 days per week commencing next term, there will possibly be an interview through Youthcare and myself this Friday.
- Online NAPLAN testing has finished for students in Years 3 & 5 online except for Year 3 writing. All went well but would recommend that our laptops are upgraded.
- Class DOJO has been implemented across the entire school for parent/school communication. Almost 90% of school population is connected and view regularly.
- Canteen has been re-opened on Mondays using volunteers.
- A new uniform shop co-coordinator has volunteered to open the shop on Monday mornings.
